



2020/01456/FUL – 1 Merrick Cottages, St Nicholas

This application was considered at our meeting of January 11, 2021.

Concerns were considered, including those rerated to the:

- Location in the Conservation Area
- Large flat roof
- Shadowing of neighbouring property
- Southwest facing window

Members of the council understand the residents desire to improve their property. However, Members resolved to object to this proposal.

Of concern is the appearance of the flat roof of the proposed extension as this is within the **Conservation Area** and visible from the street.

Members are particularly concerned about the **overshadowing** of the rear of 2 Merrick Cottages and how it would be possible for the owner of 1 Merrick cottages, to maintain and repair the wall that would stand as the boundary. It appears that access to the rear garden of 2 Merrick Cottages would be required to paint the wall and remove and replace the render.

We have referred to the LDP's, Supplementary Planning Guidance: 'Residential & Householder Development' in forming our view.
